AKC Agility Trial: June 4 – 6, 2021



## COVID19 Policies & Procedures

- If you are ill or have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days, or if you or someone in your home has symptoms in the last 24 hours, PLEASE STAY HOME.
- Clubs, officials and participants are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held.
- Practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines (minimum of 6 feet). Avoid congregating to the extent possible. Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
- Wash hands as frequently as possible with soap for a minimum of 20 seconds.
- Bathroom doors will be propped open. No dogs allowed in bathrooms and no filling water buckets either. Bathrooms will be wiped down periodically.
- Face masks are **REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES** while inside Canine Sport Zone (including when running the course) and outside when social distancing is not possible. Masks will be available for purchase in the CSZ vending machine for \$1 per mask.
- Hand sanitizer dispensers will be placed in strategic areas throughout the building for everyone to use.
- High traffic/touch areas will be cleaned periodically throughout the day.
- Entrances and exits to the building are clearly marked on the attached diagram. These rules will be strictly enforced.
- There will be no pens or markers available – Please Bring Your Own.
- Canine Sports Zone chairs will NOT be available inside or outside the ring – Please Bring Your Own.
- Crating will be allowed in the building; however, Exhibitors are encouraged to work from their vehicle if weather permits. X-pens and round playpens will NOT be allowed in the crating area.
- Please be respectful of Exhibitors working out of their vehicles and allow them space to get their dogs in and out.
- The large step-activation water fountain outside of the restrooms will be available. We encourage you to bring your own water.
- The kitchen will be CLOSED and off limits to all Exhibitors.
- MACH/PACH cakes or food sharing will not be allowed.
- The Liver Lady will be onsite on Saturday & Sunday!

### Workers

- Course Builders – Must check in with Carrie and/or Wendy to receive specific assignment(s). Do not share course maps with others. Gloves and hand sanitizer will be available for use after course building.
- All Ring Crew MUST use their own chairs.
- Gate Steward – Please do not crowd the gate area in order to maintain a 6' barrier.
- Timer & Scribe – Will be separated a minimum of 6'. Both must bring their own pen. The table, timer console and chairs will be wiped down with each shift change.
- Transcribe – This position has been eliminated.
- Bar Setters – Gloves and/or sanitizing wipes will be available by request.

- Leash Runner – A “grabber” will be available, as well as gloves and sanitizing wipes.
- Sheet Runner - To minimize handling of scribe sheets, **only** the scribe and trial secretary will be permitted to touch them.
- As always, we strongly encourage Exhibitors to use our online sign-up!!
- CWVC’s worker raffle is still happening! One ticket for each class worked. Two tickets for each Open and Novice class worked. Two worker baskets will be given out each day.
- CWVC Workers will be provided snacks, beverages and LUNCH. Lunch will be individually served by Frank & Teresa. Snacks & beverages will be set out for self-serve.

### **Trial Logistics**

- General Briefing – Will be held inside the ring at the beginning of each day. Gates will be propped open. Exhibitors must be masked and must maintain proper social distancing from each other.
- Class Briefings - Briefings will be held for FAST and all Open & Novice classes only.
- Course Maps: Printed copies of course maps will not be provided. Maps will be posted in the building and will be available online. QR codes will be posted in the building, which can be scanned to access course maps on a smart phone. *Make sure your phone can access QR codes if you want to use this functionality.*
- Class Check-in: There will be no printed gate sheets. We will be using an app called AGILITY GATE, where you can check-in or scratch your dog, and review where we are in the running order. If you have a smart phone, there are links below to download the app. The code for the trial will be **53562** (the zip code of the site). Gate sheets will be loaded the evening before (Friday’s gate sheets will be loaded by Thursday evening). You will not be able to check in until 6:00am on the day of the trial. - We will be using REMIND to notify people what is happening in the trial. To sign up for REMIND notifications, text @jp-agility to 81010 (81010 is the TO and the message is @jp-agility). Texting rates apply. If you do not have a texting plan, you can download the REMIND app and sign up using the app instead. Use of REMIND is not necessary for this trial. Even if you signed up last time, you WILL have to sign up again.
  - PLEASE keep in mind that this is just a convenience and it may be possible that a walk through could start or dogs have started running and a remind message is missed or not delivered to your phone.
- Trial Results: Results will be posted in a binder for those who cannot access them online. We will be posting these online as soon as a jump height/class is completed. Hand sanitizer will be available by the binder for your convenience. QR codes will be posted in the building, which can be scanned to access results on a smart phone. *Make sure your phone can access QR codes if you want to use this functionality.*
- Ribbons & Stickers: Once the judge has approved class results, stickers will be placed on the appropriate ribbon(s) and placed on a table for pick-up. Exhibitors who do not want ribbons, may return them to the CWVC and the stickers can be transferred to a note card.
